

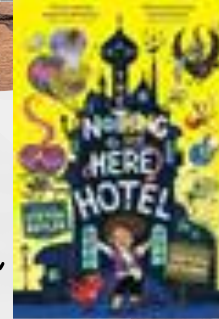
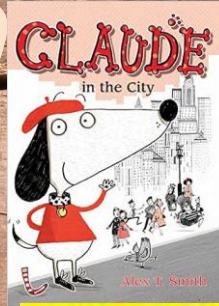

Reading

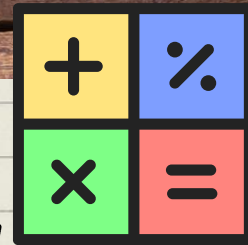
Comprehension lessons take place twice a week.

Maths

We will be looking at:

- Multiplication and Division
- Measurement – Mass, Capacity and Length and Perimeter.

Children will be expected to know their 3's, 4's, 8 and 11 timetables by the end of Year 3.



Science

We will study:

What makes a healthy, balanced diet/What food labels on packaging show/The different types of skeletons that animals have/.How muscles help us to move.



Religious Education

We will be learning about Christmas and Listening to God's Word at Mass.

Each term, children will work together to plan, lead and present a Collective Worship for the class.

As the children are making their First Holy Communion this year, it is important that they try and join us for 9am Sunday Mass to sing in the choir. If they can't attend, we ask that they try and attend mass at one of the other times.



Geography

Children will focus on the topic 'Who lives in Antarctica?' We will learn map skills, physical and human features of Antarctica and plan and complete an expedition around our school.
