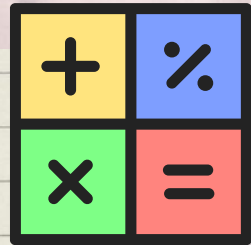

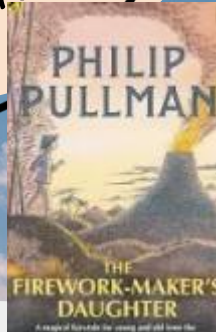

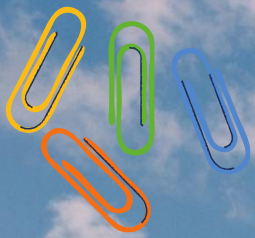

Sound Sc4/4.1a identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating c4/4.1b recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear sc4/4.1c find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.
