

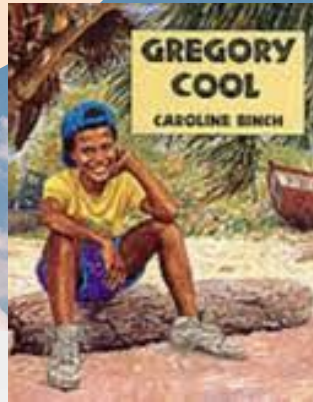

English

We are reading



This term we will focus on the contemporary fiction book

Our writing outcomes will consist of a setting description and an informal letter.

We will look at contemporary poetry and write our own poems.

We will continue our Grammar learning and handwriting lessons.

We will continue developing our fluency, pace, and comprehension skills.

Reading Comprehension lessons take place twice a week.

Maths

We will be looking at:

- Adding and subtracting fractions
- Problem solving with fractions
- Money
- Time

It is extremely important that all children learn their 3, 4, 8 and 11 times tables by heart.



Science – We will learn:

- How seeds are dispersed and begin to grow
- What plants need to grow
- To understand the functions of roots, stems, leaves, and flowers
- About pollination, fertilisation, and plant life cycles



Religious Education

We will learn about the Easter story and Pentecost.

We will also spend time preparing children for the sacrament of First Holy Communion.

As the children are making their First Holy Communion this year, it is important that they try and join us for 9am Sunday Mass to read or sing in the choir. If they can't attend, we ask that they try and attend mass at one of the other times.



Geography

This half term in Geography we will be studying the topic 'Are all settlements the same?'

The children will look at types of settlements, settlement patterns, and how settlements have changed over time.



Art

We will focus on the theme of Insects.
- using pencil, colour and mosaic
- exploring the work of various insect-inspired artists such as Louise Bourgeois and Jennifer Angus

Music

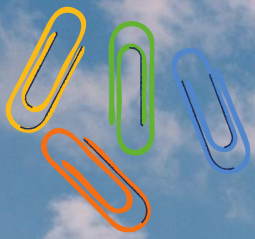
Children will continue choral lessons with Miss Pugh

Children will study the topic of Ice-creams.



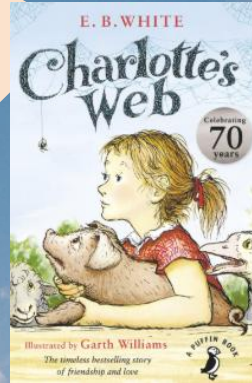

Summer Term Two in Year 3



English

We are reading



This term we will focus on the book *Charlotte's Web*.

Our writing outcomes will include a:

- setting description
- diary entry
- narrative

We will also complete an explanation writing outcome linked to our History topic.

We will be developing our fluency, pace and stamina.

Reading takes place daily and whole class reading will also take place.

Maths

We will complete Power Maths units on

- Mass and Capacity
- We will revisit addition and subtraction using the column method

We will revisit multiplication and division methods.

It is extremely important that all children know their 3, 4, 8 and 11 times tables by heart.

Science

We will learn about light by:
Identifying light sources and understanding that darkness is the absence of light

Exploring shadows and how they change
Investigating reflection and how light travels.



Religious Education

We will learn about Pentecost and Prayer. We will also focus on Collective Worship. Children will work together in small groups to plan, lead and present a Collective Worship for the class. We will reflect on our journey of faith and think about the sacraments that we have made this year.



History

Our topic for history is 'Why did the Romans Settle in Britain?'. The children will look at why the Romans invaded Britain, how Britain responded, why the Roman army was successful and how the Romans changed modern Britain.
