Elmer the Elephant

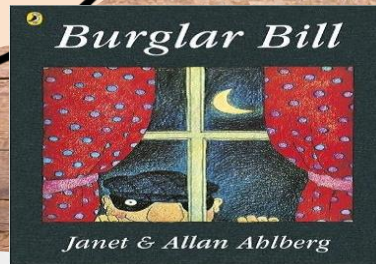
We begin our Y2 journey by celebrating our differences and writing about why we are special.

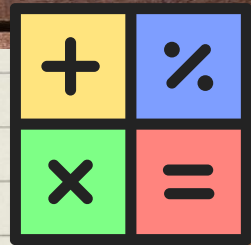
