


### English

*We are reading*




*We will be focusing on making justified inferences.*

#### Light

Identify sources of light & revise facts that light travels in straight lines & opaque objects form shadows.

Understand that to see, light needs to enter the eye. Investigate light reflection & refraction, white light made of many colours & the speed of light.

### Science

#### Electricity

1a Construct circuits, incorporating a battery & range of switches to make devices work.

1b Find out the effect of changing components in circuits, making bulbs brighter or dimmer.

Breadth of study: 1d Carry out a range of scientific investigations.

2b Recognise there are hazards in physical processes, and assess risks and take action to reduce risks to themselves and others.
