We hear the children read as regularly as we can in Year 1.

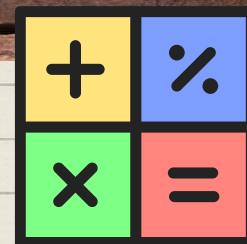
Your child will benefit greatly from reading with you each night at home..

Science

We will be looking at Animals including Humans and Seasonal Changes.

We will be investigating:

- Animal classification
 - Diets
 - The Human Body including senses
- We will also be observing the changes from Summer to Autumn.



Religious Education

In Religious Education, we will be learning about The Creation Story. We will be exploring each stage of God's Creation and identifying the wonderful things God created to make the world we live in today. We will also be researching Our Class Saints, Saint Anthony and Saint Joseph. We will share bible stories and the children will take part in collective worship in school and church.



History
