We will count objects, actions and sounds in fun and practical ways. We will develop key skills of counting objects, including saying the numbers in order and matching one number name to each item. We will also learn to subitise. This is when we can instantly recognise the number in a small group without counting.
Literacy Development We will mark make and begin to master writing our name through funky fingers, pencil control tasks and many more activities. We will begin to look at print in our environment and letters in our name. We will start to write the sounds we know to represent words when we write and will begin to talk about super sentences.	<u>Understanding the World</u> After sharing our book the Three Little Pigs we will take part in an investigation to discover which materials we can 'huff and puff'. We will be getting to know our school environment and will be learning how we get to different parts of the school. This half term we will also be exploring the changing seasons and will watch how the weather and our environment changes during Autumn. We will collect objects and explore them using our senses and will draw simple maps of our visit to the Scots lane site to remind us of what we have seen.	<i>Physical Development</i> In PE lessons and in the outdoors area we will learn to travel safely in a variety of ways e.g. hopping, skipping, running and jumping We will focus on using small movements (fine motor control) through using peg boards, tweezers and our funky fingers area to help develop our coordination.
