



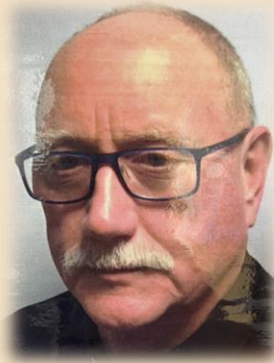
MEET OUR GOVERNORS

CTK Eco Pledge



This week we launched our recycling initiative with a visit from Team Recycle. Children have been asked to bring into school, HDPE plastic items which have the resin code number 2 printed on the item. (see image below)



As explained in the workshops the items to be brought in from home will be plastic milk bottles, milk bottle tops, water bottle tops and pop bottle tops.

Please could you ensure each item has been thoroughly cleaned before being brought into school and children will then place the items in our Team Recycle bins that will be on site. Following this, all items will be taken to the Team Recycle factory as shown on the assembly video.

Once all items have been granulated and then placed in a heat press, a unique display will be created for our school, which will be made from 100% recycled plastics collected from your children.

This gives all children the opportunity to be part of and understand the full recycling process, and we hope that this will encourage them to recycle at home and at school as part of their daily lives.

We really appreciate you supporting with this initiative and we hope that the impact the Team Recycle project makes will inspire and encourage your children to make a positive contribution to help protect our planet.

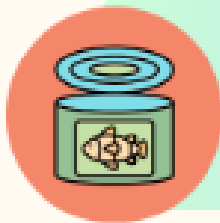


As part of our Harvest Festival celebrations we are hosting a

Well done Phoebe, we are so proud of all you have achieved.



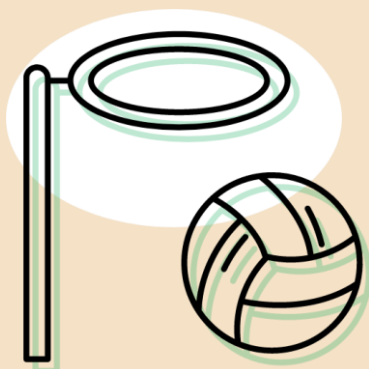

Thanks to William for serving at the Coventry Catholic Schools' Partnership Vocations Mass on Wednesday evening.

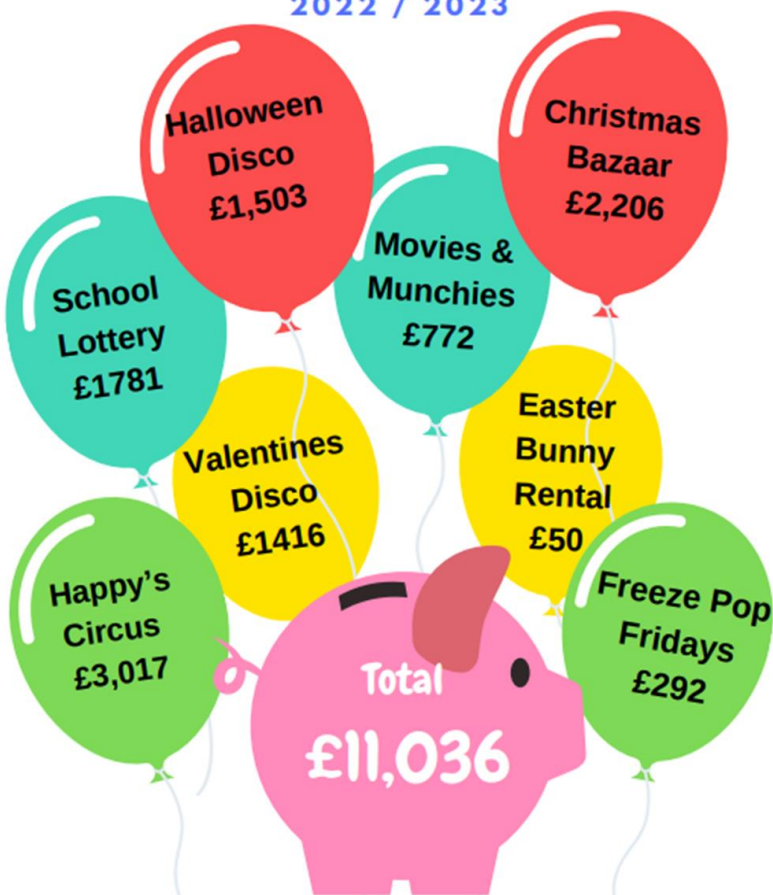

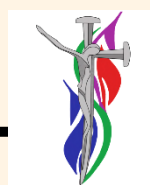

Why is good attendance important?

To ensure pupils reach their full potential both socially and academically a high level of attendance and punctuality is essential. **The expectation by the Department for Education and Local Authority is that all children's school attendance will be 95% or above each academic year.** By law, all children of compulsory school age must receive a suitable full-time education. Parents have a legal responsibility to make sure that their child attends school regularly. This means that your child should not have sessions of unauthorised absence.

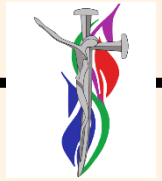
Ongoing attendance percentage

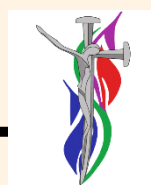

SAFEGUARDING AT CTK



Unfortunately, we have an increasing number of dangerous drivers at both WHR and SL site. This is putting both children and adults at risk.

Over the last two weeks staff have witnessed a number of adults -

- Driving into the church carpark at WHR through the exit route .
- Parking at WHR in front of the school gates and blocking the emergency exit as well as causing a traffic jam.
- Leaving car engines on while adults run into school to collect their child.
- Parking on double yellow lines or on the yellow zig zag lines.
- Parking over the entrance to Fullers Close near SL site causing a traffic jam and not allowing children and adults to cross the road safely.

The above incidents have caused great concerns for both staff and parents. Please take the time to park sensibly when dropping your child off at school or collecting them at the end of the day.

We would also advise parents that have to park in the church carpark at WHR site to not move their vehicle between 3:10 - 3:25 until all of the children have safely left the site.
