#### Why is good attendance important?

To ensue pupils reach their full potential both socially and academically a high level of attendance and punctuality is essential. The expectation by the Department for Education and Local Authority is that all children's school attendance will be 95% or above each academic year. By law, all children of compulsory school age must receive a suitable full-time education. Parents have a legal responsibility to make sure that their child attends school regularly. This means that your child should not have sessions of unauthorised absence.

#### Ongoing attendance percentage

At CTK we carefully monitor your child's attendance and punctuality percentage on a daily, weekly and monthly basis to ensure that pupils are attending school for 95% of the time in line with the DfE expectations.

#### Reporting your child's absence

Please ensure you phone school before <u>9.00am</u> to inform us of your child's absence if they are not going to be in or you are running late. Reasons such as 'unwell' or 'poorly' are not valid, we need to know what the symptoms are. Thank you for your co-operation.


