This weeks focus - Sexing

Sexting involves the sending, receiving or forwarding explicit messages, images, or video of a sexual nature. Although mobile phones are the most common vehicle for sexting, the term can also apply to sending sexually explicit messages through any digital media such as email, instant messaging and social media sites. These messages can be sent to or from a friend, boyfriend, girlfriend or someone your child has met online. Sexting is often described as "the new flirting" for children, but it is illegal for anyone under the age of 18. Some of the main platforms that sexting occurs on are Snapchat, WhatsApp, Facebook Messenger and Instagram.

PERCEIVED AS 'BANTER'

Many young people under 18 see sexting as 'banter' and an easy way to show someone that they like and trust them. Whilst it is a criminal offence, the reasons for taking and sharing can be very innocent and all part of growing up, understanding their own sexuality, and establishing a relationship. However, whilst most images and videos are taken and shared willingly, there can be unintentional consequences, embarrassment, humiliation, and emotional hurt.

NO CONTROL



Once a photo or video is out there, there's no way of knowing how many people have saved it, tagged it, or shared it. Children like to show off to their peers and, suddenly, an image has gone beyond its intended recipient to classmates, friends, and even strangers. Once an image or video has been shared online, there's nothing to stop it being archived and repeatedly shared.

Many young people who are victims of cyberbullying suffer in silence.

They feel they can't turn to parents or a trusted adult for support as they fear they may get in trouble or have their devices taken away from them. It can carry on all day, all evening and all weekend for the world to see, causing a lot of emotional stress to the victim and their family.
