This year, Mrs Walsh established the Coventry Book Bank to highlight the problem that exists across the city.

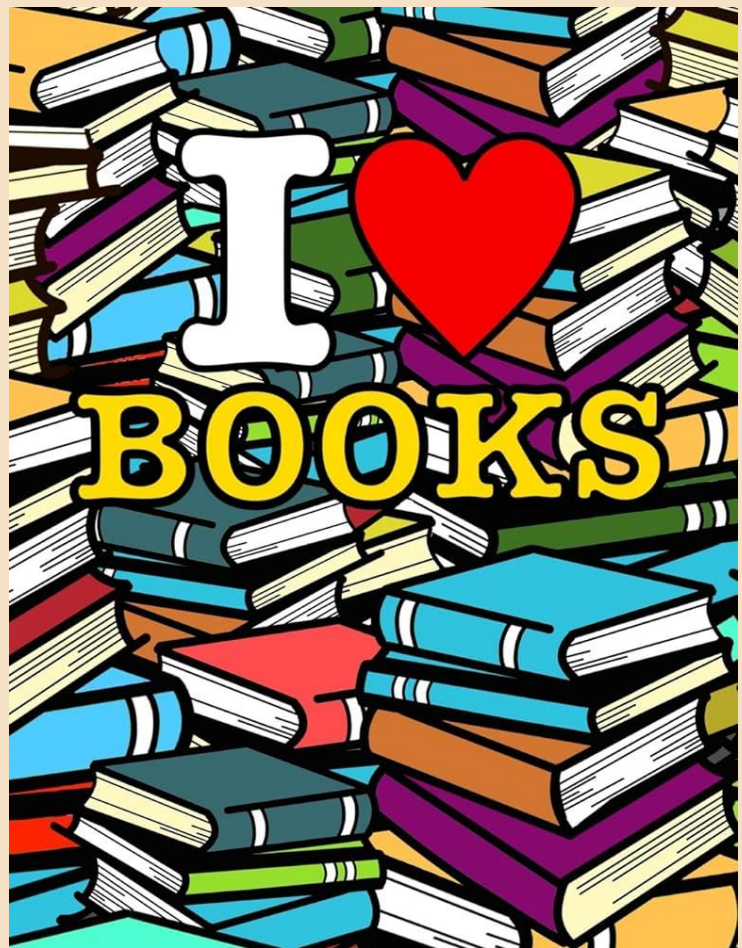
Many children in schools and in the care system do not have any reading books of their own.

Isla has learned to swim without her belt, breathe from the side and get a sinker from the bottom of the deep end. Well done Isla-Rose, we are very proud of you!



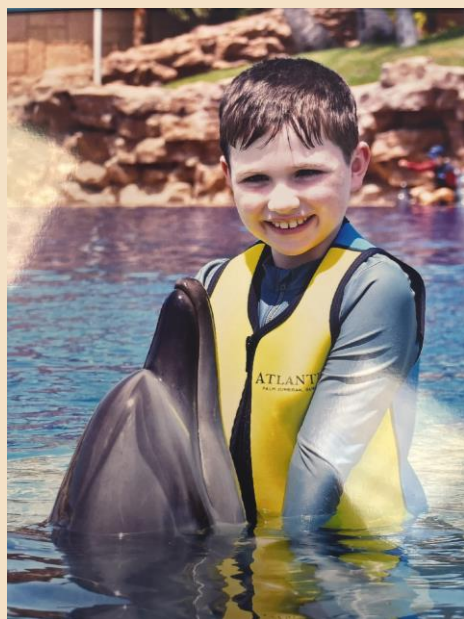

Hope prayed for our school community and hopes that she will have the opportunity to return to Lourdes again in the future.





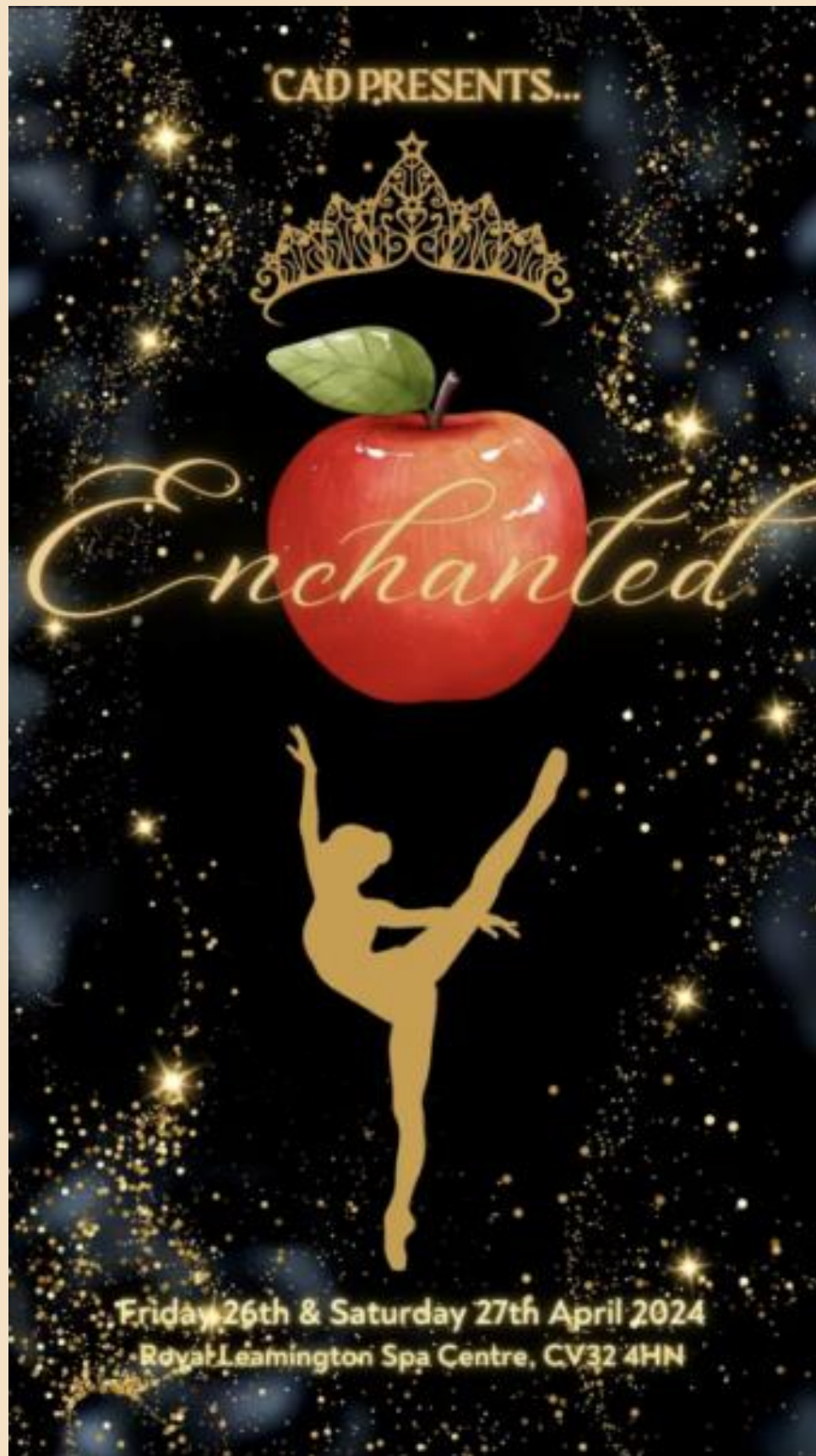

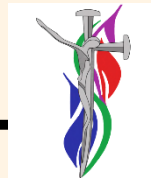

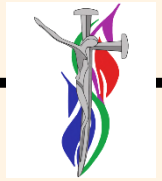

**This weeks focus – Upsetting content**

In this guide, you'll find tips on ways to sensitively address upsetting news content that children may have seen online

### FIND OUT WHAT YOUR CHILD KNOWS 1

There are many ways that children are exposed to upsetting content in the media, both online and offline. Before swamping your child with information, find out what they know already. Show them you're interested in what they have to say, practice active listening and try to gauge how much your child has been impacted by what they've seen.

### RIGHT TIME, RIGHT PLACE 2

Starting a conversation about upsetting content probably isn't the best idea when your child is studying for an exam or about to go to bed. Choose a time when they're relaxed and open to talking, to make sure you have their full attention. Remember, these conversations can become emotional, so choose somewhere your child feels safe and comfortable.

### KEEP IT AGE APPROPRIATE 3

With younger children, try and keep the conversation more general and avoid leading questions and complex detail. You can go slightly deeper into the specifics with young teenagers but keep monitoring their emotional response. With older teens, you can be more open about the realities and consequences of what's happening – but again, do stay aware of their emotional state.

### EMPHASISE HOPE 4

Upsetting content can make anyone feel angry, scared, sad or overwhelmed. Try to find stories of hope, generosity and strength related to the content you're discussing. Children often feel reassured when they know they can do something to help, so encourage your child's sense of control through activities which make them feel they're positively impacting the events they're concerned about.

## 2024 Coventry Half Marathon Road Closures

#### Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2024

#### Start Time: 09:00

Run For All are extremely pleased to be working in partnership with Coventry Council to deliver the Coventry Half Marathon.

In accordance with Coventry Council being the highway authority for the Metropolitan District of Coventry, an order has been made prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads and road junctions by vehicles in order to facilitate the safe holding of the Coventry Half Marathon.

The event will require the closure of roads and road junctions as well as the suspension of a number of Traffic Regulation Orders between 04:00 and 15:00 on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2024. Please note, all roads either crossing or having a junction with the listed roads will also be closed at that point. The event will also require parking suspensions from 18:00 Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2024 to 13:00 Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2024 to aid in the safe running of the event.

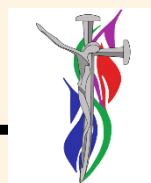
