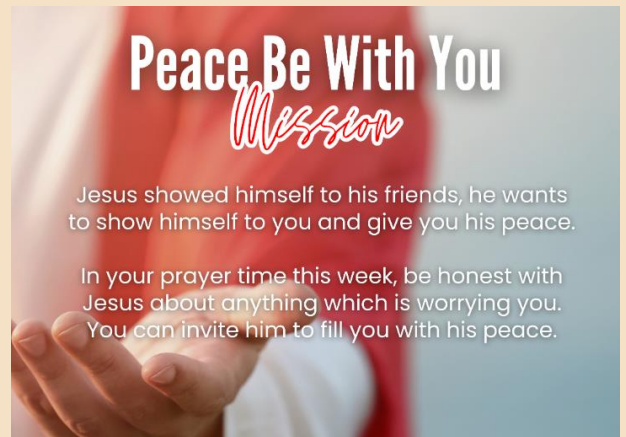

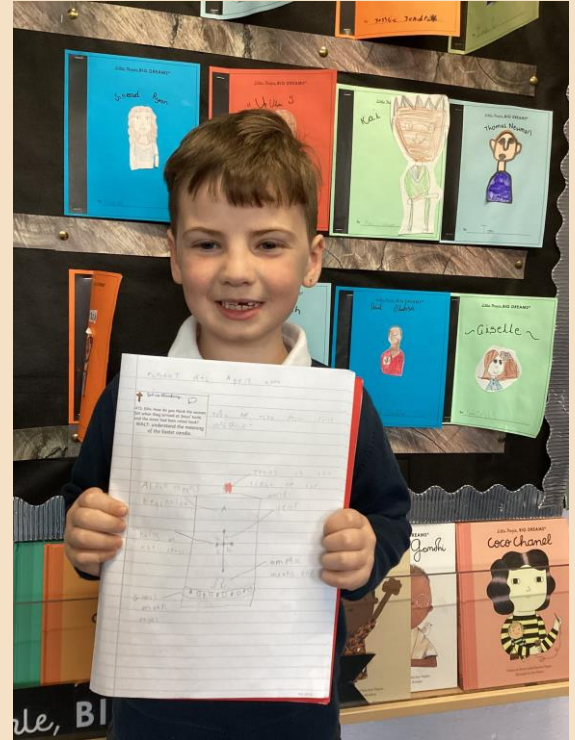

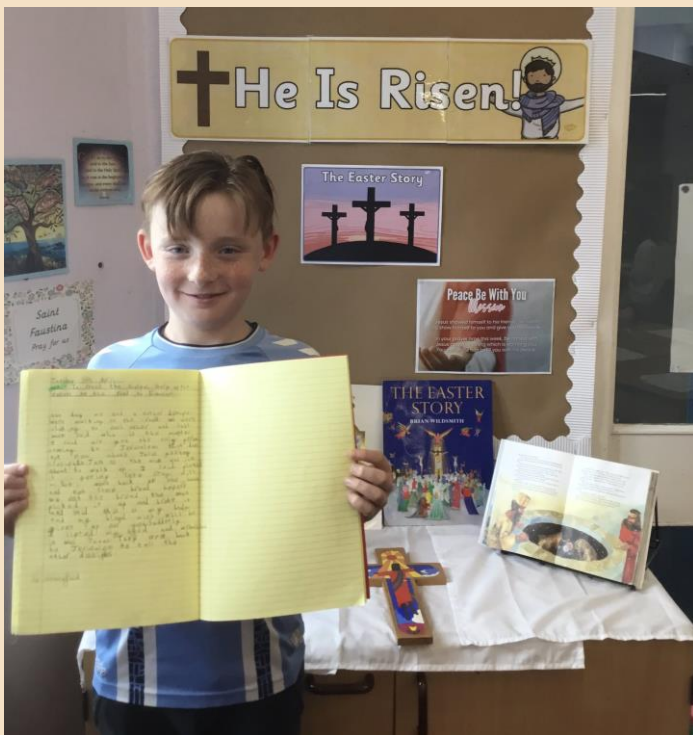


Nursery had a lovely time at their Family Faith Day sessions, learning about the joy of Easter. Alleluia!

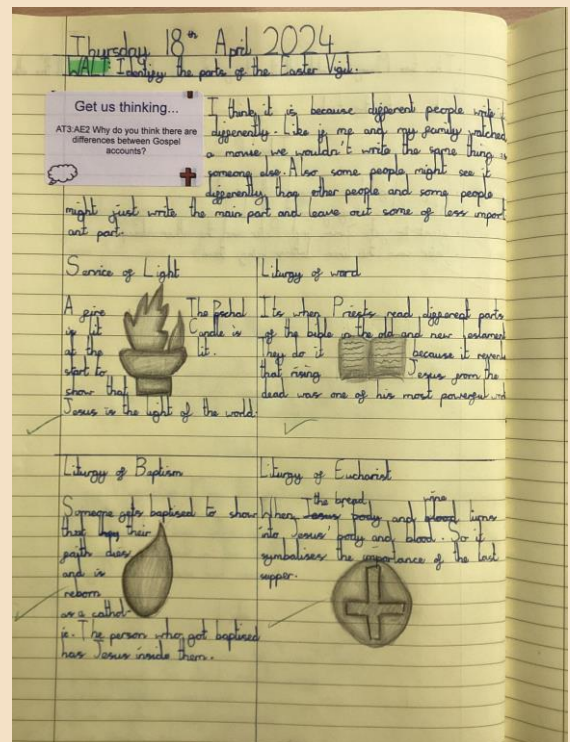

This year, Mrs Walsh established the Coventry Book Bank to highlight the problem that exists across the city.

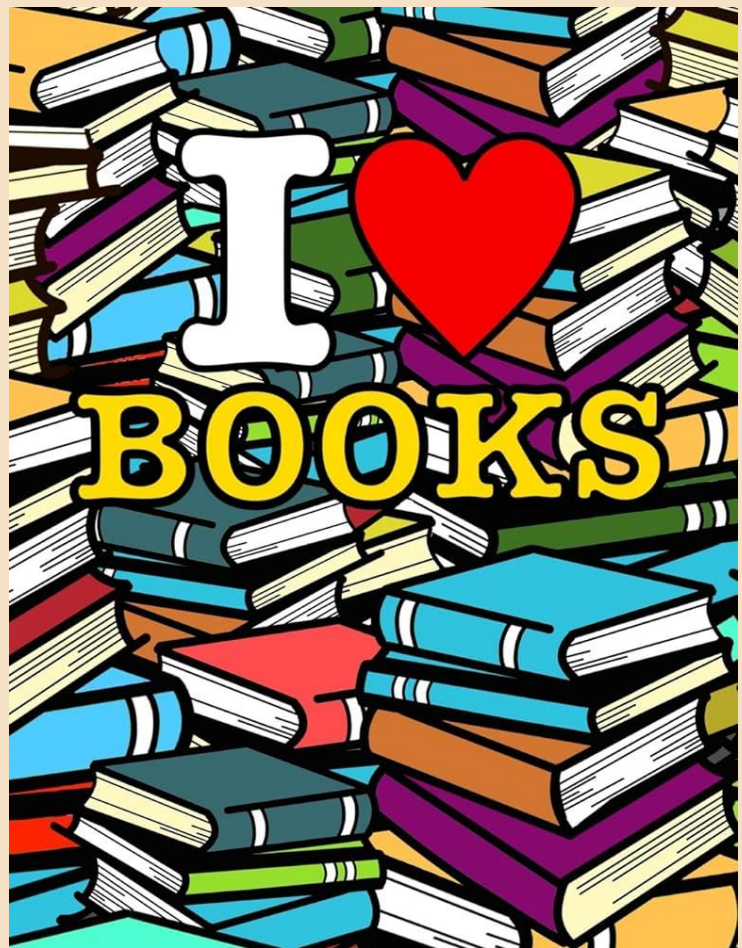
Many children in schools and in the care system do not have any reading books of their own.

This weeks focus – Township

Potentially addictive online games are nothing new, but the specifics of this kind of media can vary enormously – and, as a consequence, the risks in each individual game are just as diverse.

The city-builder Township is no exception: providing its legions of devotees with accessible, satisfying fun ... but exposing them to potential hazards at the same time



MISLEADING PUBLICITY

Township's developers have previously faced criticism for advertising the game on social media by using clips of gameplay which can't actually be found in the final product. This may well lead to a child or young person downloading the game with severely misplaced expectations of what they'll be playing.

IN-GAME ADVERTS

While it's common for mobile games to feature in-game advertisements for other products and services, Township employs a particularly egregious strategy seen in several similar products. It offers users in-game currency in exchange for watching such adverts, which can obviously encourage young people to willingly expose themselves to marketing material.

IN-GAME PURCHASES

The game's core concept of building up a settlement to increase its population and income can feel slow paced at first – and players are incentivised to spend real-world money to move things along more quickly. That can mean handing over anything from £1.99 to £19.99 for these in-game boosts: amounts that can rapidly add up to a considerable sum if left unchecked.

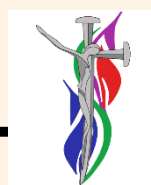

2024 Coventry Half Marathon Road Closures

Important Information for Residents and Businesses

Sunday 28th April 2024

Start Time: 09:00

Run For All are extremely pleased to be working in partnership with Coventry Council to deliver the Coventry Half Marathon.

In accordance with Coventry Council being the highway authority for the Metropolitan District of Coventry, an order has been made prohibiting and restricting the use of certain roads and road junctions by vehicles in order to facilitate the safe holding of the Coventry Half Marathon.

The event will require the closure of roads and road junctions as well as the suspension of a number of Traffic Regulation Orders between 04:00 and 15:00 on Sunday 28th April 2024. Please note, all roads either crossing or having a junction with the listed roads will also be closed at that point. The event will also require parking suspensions from 18:00 Saturday 27th April 2024 to 13:00 Sunday 28th April 2024 to aid in the safe running of the event.

A full list of road closures, including approximate times, is provided overleaf. We would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your support of the 2024 Coventry Half Marathon.

Please note; access for emergency service vehicles shall be retained throughout the duration of the event.
