ARE YOU WATER WISE?

Did you know that every day, on average, we use about 150 litres of water? A shocking one third of this, (that's about 50 litres) gets wasted every single day!

Discover how much water you and your family use by completing the steps in this pack (you'll need an adult to help!) Don't worry if you haven't got a meter you can skip those steps.



Locate and read your water meter



Complete the daily water usage chart



Change how you use water



Read your water meter following your changes

Repeat this activity for several weeks for a real difference in your water usage!

HOW TO READ YOUR WATER METER

If you're not on a water meter please skip this step

Taking readings from your water meter is a great way of finding out exactly how much water you use at home!

Finding your water meter

OUTSIDE:

Usually located at the stop valve. Look for a small metal or plastic cover in your driveway, garden, playground or nearby footpath.

INSIDE:

Usually located at the water pipe as it enters the home or near the stop tap. Look under the kitchen sink or downstairs toilet!

What will my water meter look like?



Your meter will usually look like this



How much water is a cubic meter?

1 cubic meter = 1,000L

That's the same as:

125 toilet flushes

84 hand washes under a running tap



How to read your water meter

When you read your meter you only need to read the 4 numbers in the black boxes. There will be 4 or 5 of these.



These show the number of cubic meters of water you have used.

BRUSH UP YOUR WATER-SAVING SKILLS

A running tap uses **six litres** of water every minute. So make sure to turn it **off while you brush!**

MAXIMISE YOUR MACHINE WASH

Washing machines work at their best on a **full load** (but don't overdo it)! And if you're buying a new machine, check out its **water-efficiency**.



FILL UP THAT DISHWASHER

Only turn on your dishwasher **when it's full**. A half-empty dishwasher wastes water, as it uses the same amount of water **no matter how many dishes** you have stacked inside.



DITCH THE HOSEPIPE - GET A WATER BUTT

A typical British house roof sees enough rain to fill a water butt **dozens of times a year**. Get a water butt - your plants will **blooming love it!**
